



**Please consider the following when drafting your boat security plan:**

- On land
  - If boat is kept inside a building or gated area, describe security in place to protect the boat from theft or vandalism? For instance, is it gated, well lighted, are there security guards?
  - Is it ever kept on a trailer?
  - Do you use prop or drive locks?
- In Water
  - If you store the boat on a lift, will you cut power to the lift?
  - Do you have ignition interlock or other means to disable engines?
- General
  - Have you experienced any prior theft or vandalism? If so, explain details.
  - Has there been any other theft or vandalism at this location that you know of?
  - How will your boat be locked?
  - Do you use any motion sensors, alarms or cameras? How and where?
  - Have you kept documented records and photos?
  - Where will the electronics, fishing gear and other removable items be stored?
